The Asian Insurance Forum (AIF), a flagship event organised annually by the Insurance Authority (IA), will be held on 7 December 2021 under the theme of “Opportunities and Challenges in the Post-pandemic New Normal”.

The programme covers four discussion panels made up of financial regulators, C-suite executives, academic experts, venture capitalists and professional service providers, shedding light on a number of contemporary topics such as the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area, the dual circulation economic strategy, climate change and green finance, Fintech development¹ and regulatory outlook.
